



Federal-HIPUtah Monthly Premiums

Premium rates are evaluated on a biannual basis.

Premiums for Federal-HIPUtah coverage are calculated based on age and deductible options. The premiums are listed in the following table. Premium increases due to an age category change are effective the first of the month following the birth date.
