What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	Per calendar year. Single: <b>\$8,050</b> in-network. Family (two or more): <b>\$8,050</b> person/ <b>\$16,100</b> family in-network.	Generally, you must pay all the costs from <b>providers</b> up to the <b>deductible</b> amount before this <b>plan</b> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <b>plan</b> , each family member must meet their own individual <b>deductible</b> until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <b>deductible</b> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. <u>Preventive</u> care is covered before you meet your <u>Deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . What is the <u>out-of-pocket</u> <u>limit</u> for this <u>plan</u> ?	Per calendar year. Single: <b>\$8,050</b> in-network. Family (two or more): <b>\$8,050</b> person/ <b>\$16,100</b> family in-network.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
What is not included in the <u>out–of–pocket limit</u> ?	Premiums, balance-billed charges, preventive services, healthcare this plan doesn't cover, and penalties for failure to obtain preauthorization for services. This <u>plan</u> uses a <u>provider network</u> . You will pay less if you use a <u>provider</u> in the <u>plan's network</u> . You will pay the most if you use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> , and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the <u>provider's</u> charge and what your <u>plan</u> pays ( <u>balance billing</u> ). Be aware your <u>network</u> <u>provider</u> might use an <u>out-of-network provider</u> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <u>provider</u> before you get services.

#### Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

#### Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes
